6. IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON COVID19 PANDEMIC

The fundamental principle through all Sport events during the Covid-19 era is to Protect and Be Protected by wearing a mask, sanitising, distancing and respecting the recommendations of "**the Protocol for resuming events during the Covid-19 pandemic**" hereafter referred to as COVID-19 Protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect each other.

Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor President etc.) must have read and understood the COVID-19 Protocol which can be found below.

The COVID-19 vaccines provide protection to the vaccinated only against seriously falling ill, but not against getting infected or transmitting the virus to somebody else, even if the chances of the latter is very low. Therefore, until vaccination reaches a high level among the karate family and there are other effective preventive methods available, or until it is globally accepted to conduct activities without safety measures, all the participants of any event must follow the same protocol (being PCR tested before the event, upon arrival, during the event, wear a mask, wash hands, follow the bubble system, etc.) to protect and be protected, in the spirit of unity and solidarity which is in our community's moral code.

6.1. COVID-19 Documents

All pre-event COVID-19 documents must be submitted to the Secretariat during the on site registration / accreditation process.

6.2. Before travelling

I. Passports must be valid for **at least 6 months** from the date of arrival. Check if you need a **visa**, and if yes, request it from the Local Organising Committee (LOC) according to the details in the visa section.

II. Get an **Entry Permission Letter** for entry to Kazakhstan from the LOC.

III. Book accommodation and send a detailed rooming list.

IV. Upon arrival, **one (1) negative individual medical PCR COVID-19 test certificates** in English must be provided, not more than 72 hours before registration. If you experience any kind of symptoms do not start to travel (even with a negative PCR test). Airlines may require you to show this on check-in and some airlines require the certificate to be no more than 72 hours or less before arrival to your destination (please check with your airline).



6.3. Entering Kazakhstan

I. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure they follow the rules of the Kazakhstan Government and the AKF to participate in the Almaty AKF 2021.

II. All border-crossing regulations must be followed regarding the validity of passports and visas, as applicable for each respective country.

III. **All participants (regardless of vaccination status) MUST have 1 PCR Test with validity of no more than 72 hours.**

IV. All participants must have a printed copy of the **Entry Permission Letter** from OC.

V. All participants MUST complete the **Liability Waiver Form Declaration (as attached to the appendix of this document).**

6.4. Entering The Bubble

The event venues (hotels, sport hall, training hall etc.) will be classified as bubbles and to reduce risk a “bubble to bubble” concept will be used. **People are NOT allowed to leave their bubble** as contamination could occur endangering the safety of the event and the health of the participants.

The ALMATY AKF 2021 hotel **bubble opens** from: **12 December 2021**. If due to flight schedules you need to arrive earlier, contact the LOC and they will assist you with a solution.

Rapid Antigen test will be performed immediately upon arrival. Until test results are obtained, all participants **must remain in their hotel rooms**, where water and any paid meals will be ensured until the receipt of the test results. Without Rapid Antigen Test Negative, it will be impossible to enter the “Bubble Zone” or be accredited. Latest entering the bubble zone is fixed on : **15 December 2021**.

6.5. Throughout your stay

- I. Wash/sanitise your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
- II. No handshake - greet each other with a bow.
- III. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks must be worn in dining areas at all times, except when eating.
- IV. Maintain **1.5 m distance** at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with **ONE PARTNER**.
- V. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the LOC on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited populations. Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their Delegation COVID-19 Manager, the AKF COVID-19 Manager and the AKF ALMATY OC COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the AKF ALMATY OC COVID-19 Manager and the AKF COVID-19 Manager.
- VI. Close contact – a close contact (for the purpose of isolation/quarantine) is considered as a person who is/was:
 - Sharing the same hotel room.
 - Had face-to-face contact at a distance of less than two meters for more than 15 minutes (i.e. training or warm-up partner).
 - Seated together in an aircraft or other means of transport without wearing a mask.
 - Having shared the same place of life as the confirmed positive or probable positive case.
 - Having had direct contact with a tested positive person, face to face, less than 2 meters, regardless of the duration (ex. conversation, meals, physical contact). But people who have crossed in the public space rapidly, even without wearing a mask, are not considered as close contact persons or persons at risk
 - Having provided or received acts of hygiene or care.
 - Having shared a confined (closed) space (office or meeting room, personal vehicle, etc.) for at least 15 consecutive or cumulative minutes over 24 hours with a tested positive person, or having remained face to face with a tested positive person during several episodes of coughing or sneezing of this last one.

6.6. Rules & Regulation, And Additional Information

Due to the current emergency health situation, this event will be held under the :

AKF KAZAKHSTAN OC 2021 SPORT COVID PROTOCOL.

Due to the current situation, the granting of accreditation and the entrance to the stadium will be possible only for participants that comply with the "Sanitary Bubble" Local COVID. The "Sanitary Bubble" starts at your arrival at Almaty Airport and finishes at your departure on 23 December 2021. During this period, the Organizing Committee will organize your journey: Hotels, Shuttle from Airport to Hotel round trip and from Hotel to Sports Hall if needed and Catering.



Please note that it is **COMPULSORY** to pre-book your hotel before **1st November** through the Organizing Committee. This pre-booking needs to be done carefully, as close as possible to your final needs. Taking into consideration the holding of AKF events after the pre-booking deadline **1st November 2021**.

- I. In order to safe and secure the championships, all participants must comply with the “bubble zone rules” to be accommodated at the official hotel only.
- II. **Transportation of participants will be done by special buses. Buses will be disinfected twice a day: after taking the competitors to the gym and after the end of daily obligations.**
- III. Only accredited participants of the events can use the transport. Participants must wear face masks in the transport.
- IV. The diet of the competitors will be designed to meet the physical, religious and other needs as provided by KKF regulations.
- V. There will be hand sanitizers at the entrance to the restaurant.
- VI. Dining tables will be arranged so that there is the necessary distance between the guests.
- VII. Negative PCR test on Covid 19 no older than 72 hours before the arrival to the events. Submit the document immediately upon arrival at the airport.
- VIII. Upon arrival teams will get tested for rapid antigen test at the hotel. Please, note that in case of a positive result you will get tested for PCR test as well.
- IX. Teams must arrive in Almaty, Kazakhstan no later than 15 December 2021 by Almaty time in order to receive the results of the Rapid Antigen test for the organizing committee before the start of the events program.
- X. Provide a sufficient amount of protective masks for each member of the delegation. Wearing a mask is mandatory for all participants except for training and fights.
- XI. Due to the pandemic situation teams have to purchase refundable tickets only.
- XII. Each team is required to appoint a COVID-19 officer. The Kazakhstan Karate Federation strongly recommends other national federations to appoint their team doctor as a COVID-19 officer or Head of Delegation (Team Leader/Manager).
- XIII. In case of any problems with participants that may raise the suspicion of Covid-19 infection, the team leader has to immediately report to the LOC for examination.
- XIV. Transportation of participants will be done by special buses. Buses will be disinfected twice a day: after taking the competitors to the gym and after the end of daily obligations.
- XV. Only accredited participants of the events can use the transport and must wear face masks in the transport.

In case of a positive test result we will follow the Kazakhstan Ministry of Health procedure. Any symptoms after arrival or Anyone who experiences symptoms after arrival must immediately contact their Team COVID-19 Manager who should then contact the AKF ALMATY OC 2021 COVID-19 Manager:

Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the LOC. The cost must be paid by the National Federation. If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

Insurance

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs, including repatriation. The LOC of the event and the AKF accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.

7. “Sanitary Bubble”.

Due to the worldwide health situation, the 2021 Asian Karate Championships will take place under different circumstances, in order to safe and secure the championships, a number of rules and restrictions will apply. To ensure the safety of all participants, as well as the equity between participants from all over Asia, the organization will apply a “Sanitary Bubble” that needs to be strictly observed. For this reason, please take into account that it is compulsory, for all participants that will apply for an accreditation, to:

- Book the hotel through the Organization Committee Only: pre-booking compulsory before November 10, 2021. For the moment, 3 hotels have been entirely privatized for the event. We need an estimation of the number of participants and kind of rooms required as accurately as possible to adjust the number of hotels accordingly.
- Book the shuttle between Airport and Hotels through the Organization Committee Only.
- Stay in the “Sanitary Bubble” during your whole stay. Leaving the hotel for any reason will be strictly prohibited, except for competition time and meals.
- Respect the protocol and safety rules.

As mentioned earlier, delegations have to use official accommodation and reserve it through the Organizing Committee's official partner Travel Agency. If the procedure stated below is not followed, participants will not be entitled to accreditation (Official, Referees, Coaches, Staff, Athletes).



8. Official Hotels, Local Transportation & Catering (Travel Agency)

Delegations are obligatory to use official accommodation and reserve it only through the Organizing Committee's official partner agency.

Participants who do not follow the procedure stated in this bulletin and do not book accommodation through the official agency will not be entitled to accreditation and will not get their accreditation cards.

Please book your airport transfer, visa application, hotel bookings, and PCR Test using the standard form as attached to the bulletin.

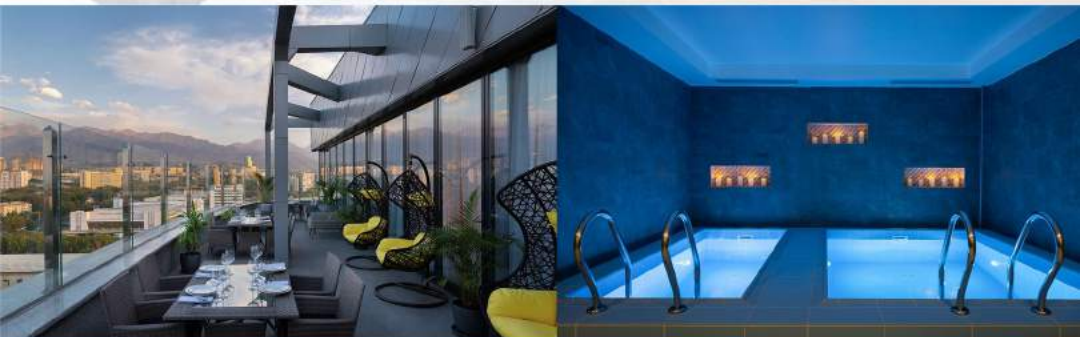

Almaty is the largest city in Kazakhstan, with a population of about 2 millions. It was the capital of Kazakhstan from 1929 to 1997. Almaty is still the major commercial and cultural centre of Kazakhstan, as well as its most populous and most cosmopolitan city. The city is located in the mountainous area of Southern Kazakhstan. Almaty remains the largest, most developed and most ethnically and culturally diverse city in Kazakhstan. It has a relatively mild climate with warm and dry summers and quite cold winters.

The closest airport is Almaty International airport, located 20 km from the city.

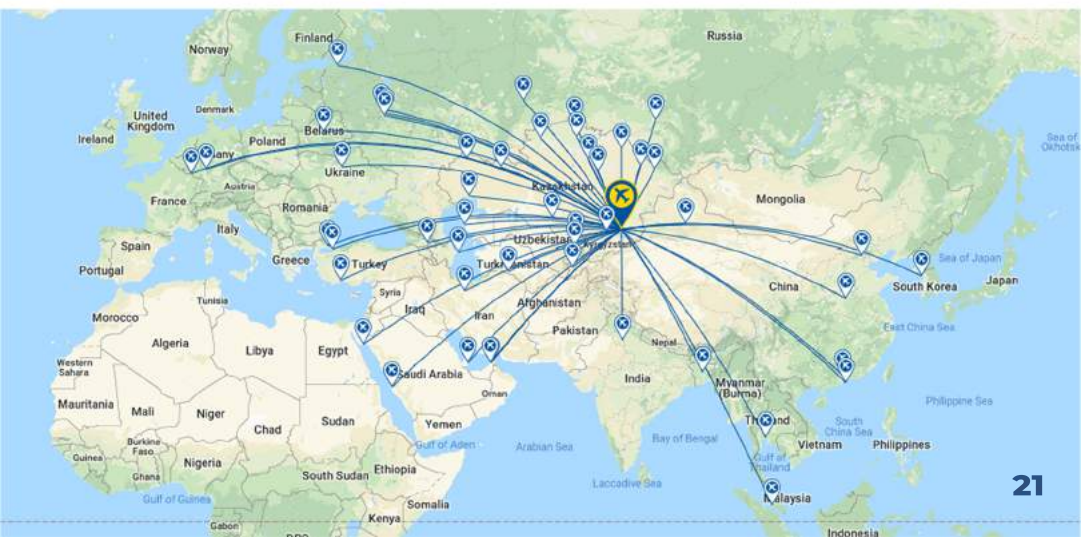

Immigration & VISA (IMPORTANT PROCESS)

Information

Because of Covid19 situation, the visa time process to be issued will be about 20 to 30 days. All countries need authorization from the Kazakhstan government and visa to enter territories.

All copy passports have to be submitted, no later than 1st November 2021, with the details listed below for all members of your delegation (Excel FORMAT):

Explanation of Kazakhstan Visa Process Time :

DAY 1	Submit All Copy Passport to the Kazakhstan Prime Minister Office for Authorization.
DAY 2 - 14	Processing Authorization called MBK (Covid Protocol Immigration).
DAY 15	MBK validation by the Gouvernement.
DAY 16	Submit MBK and Copy Passport to Police Immigration for Visa Telex Number.
DAY 17 - 25	Processing Number Telex to obtain a Visa on arrival or embassy.
DAY 25 - 30	Visa Number Deliver.
DAY 30 - 35	Visa Application request at Embassy and Delivery

Once the visa telex has been issued, please copy the KKF at kaz_kkf@hotmail.com with your request (visa/entry pass) to accelerate the process at the embassy. The Kazakh visa must be pasted into a passport or other identity paper recognized in Kazakhstan and must be valid for traveling. The visa shall give the right to enter and stay in Kazakhstan and exit from it or transit across Kazakhstan.

To secure visas, foreign nationals (or individuals without nationality) must contact the Kazakh diplomatic mission/consulate in the country of residence and submit :

- **Valid Passport (or international travel document).** The passport should expire not earlier than 3 months upon expiry of the respective visa.
- **Copy of letter of invitation** - indicating the number of a visa support letter issued by the Department of Consular Service of the Kazakhstan MFA;

or

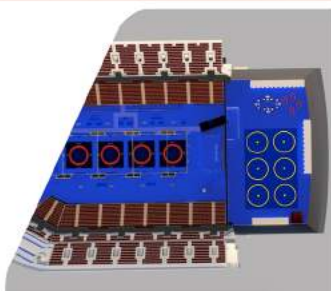
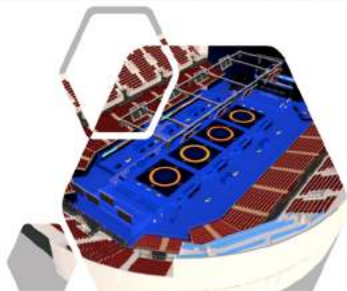

13.1 Anti-Doping

WKF Anti-doping rules shall be applied.

13.2 Registration & Accreditation of Athletes and Officials

I. All competitors, officials and officiating coaches (including accreditation course candidates) must register online using the online system between 1 October 2021 to 15 November 2021 at **AKF Online Registration: 17TH ASIAN SENIOR, AND 19TH ASIAN CADET, JUNIOR & U21 KARATE CHAMPIONSHIP 2021, Almaty Kazakhstan**

III. National federations are responsible for the registration of their delegation. Online registration for delegation will be open on 1 October 2021, and will be closed on 15 November 2021. **After the closing date, any late registration or amendments, between 16th - 30th November 2021, will be penalised with a penalties of \$20 USD per entry or per amendment.**

IV. There shall be no more registration after 30th November 2021, and there will be no new registration accepted during the on site accreditation. During the on site accreditation, any amendment will be subjected to **a penalty of USD100 per change.**

V. The Official Accreditation session will take place at the HQ Hotel, please refer to the event schedule. **A maximum of 2 persons per National Federation is allowed to attend the on site accreditation.**

VI. Each National Federation will be allocated a specific time and date for on the site accreditation. An email notification of the assigned time and date for on site accreditation will be sent to all participating NF upon receipt of confirmed arriving details.

VI. Accreditation cards will be issued during the registration on site upon the confirmation of full payment bank transfer. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

VII. **The qualification for age groups shall be with referenced to the first day of the Championship which is 18th December 2021.**

For all events, the latest official WKF rules applied. Only WKF approved Karate Gi's, protective equipment and sport items are allowed.

14. Referees & Coaches Program

14.1 Officiating Referees & Coaches

I. All NF participating in AKF Championship shall be obligated to send qualified referees to officiate. The minimum qualification of the referees to be sent by the NF is of AKF Kumite RA / Kata JA. The number of referees to be send by NF for officiating in the Championship shall be according to the number of athletes from the NF participating in the Championship, as follows:

Number of Athletes from NF	Minimum Referees from NF
5-10 athletes	1 referee
More than 10 athletes	2 referees
Less than 5 athletes	No minimum

II. If the NF cannot comply with the minimum referee requirements then the NF shall be liable to pay a levy of \$100 USD per referee short. This amount shall be payable to the Treasury of AKF during the official registration.

III. There shall be no limit to the number of Referees sent by NF for officiating in the Championship however at any one time there shall be no more than 8 referees officiating at the same time.



IV. The maximum number of officiating coaches shall be based on the following ratio:

2	2
3 - 10	3
more than 10	4

V. In view of the interruption of AKF programs due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the AKF is organising the Referee upgrading seminar & examination, and the new referee seminar & examination in the same period of time. However, each intended candidate can only choose to register for one of the programs.

VI. As part of the referee examination syllabus, those referees that passed will have to stay on to officiate in the Championship.

VII. Each NF is subject to a quota of 12 registration for referee upgrading and / or new referee examination.

VIII. Total candidates for referee examination and upgrading is subject to a maximum of 200 pax. Therefore the registration shall be of first come first serve basis.

IX. Please note that for all referees registering for officiating and renewal, when registering online, please fill in your AKF ID under the PASSPORT ID column. As for candidate referees that do not have an AKF ID, please fill in **"NEW"** under the Passport ID column.

X. There are no charges for licensed referees to register for officiating. However, the registration must be completed before the deadline. Any late registration or on site request or registration will be charged an administration fees of USD200 per referee.

XI. **All referee and coach program registration shall begin on the 1st October 2021, and closed on the 15th November 2021, 12pm (Dubai Time).**

XII. For WKF Kumite / Kata Coach, please bring along your proof of valid WKF Kumite / Kata License during on site accreditation.

XIII. Please note that all Coach licenses are valid for a period of three years. Upon expiration, the license holders will have to sit for re-examination.
